RE: Adjustment to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Qtr assessment as collected by Smugglers' and to be transferred to the Liftside Account

Listed in your Smugglers' 3<sup>rd</sup> Qtr 2014 statement issued by Smugglers', you will find an assessment amount collected on behalf of Liftside. These funds will be transferred to the SNHA office and applied to your Liftside account as has been the practice for many years. This year's 3<sup>rd</sup> Qtr assessment amount reflects an adjustment to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Qtr amount that was originally budgeted last spring according to the discussion and agreement at the July 5, 2014 Liftside Annual Meeting.

There are two aspects to the adjustment:

- 1. How the dryer vent project was paid for several years ago. The costs of dryer vent changes were originally paid for by the % of undivided interest held by each home. After review and discussion, the directors and homeowners agreed that the charges should have been allocated to each home size by what it actually cost for the changes to be made to each of the home groups.
- 2. How Smugglers' has collected the Regime Services Fee since 2009. For many years, the Regime Services charge was the same to all homes regardless of home size (% of undivided interest). After review and discussion, the directors and homeowners agreed the charge should be according to the % of undivided interest held by each home size.

The net result of the adjustments for these two charges includes a credit to studios and an additional charge to 1 and 2 bedroom homes. In order to spread out the impact of these adjustments, the Liftside Directors agreed to make the adjustments over the next 4 Liftside assessments starting with the 3<sup>rd</sup> Qrt 2014.

Also starting with the 4<sup>th</sup> Qtr 2014, Liftside will pay Smugglers' directly for the Regime Services they provide. This Regime expense will become a part of the annual Liftside operating expenses and you will see the total amount for these services listed on the Liftside Budget, and as such, will become a part of the annual Liftside assessment.
