MEMORANDUM

TO: W. Stritzler, R. Mulcahy, W. Raban

DATE: 01/14/90
RE: Telephone Fees

Just to put on paper our arrangements regarding the telephone fees which we discussed and agreed to in October, 1989.

1. Limit the Smugglers charge to HOs to the local phone company rate for service
2. Convert all phones to touch-tone with a message light.
3. Monthly charge will be, frozen at least until December 1990:
\$23.00 / month for the first phone
\$18.00 / month for each additional phone (2nd extension)
(two phones on the same extension @ \$23.00 / month)
4. Rates will change at the same time and by the same % of local rates
5. There will be no additional charges as a result of local service conversion to touchtone
6. Any future capital upgrades to the system will be at Smugglers' Notch cost. HO is not participant to decision, or asked to pay for it.

SUBJECT: Homeowner Telephone Fees

Bill S.

Our current charges to Homeowners for telephone service have been in place since late 1989. Attached is a copy of the agreement that has been in place since regarding the basis for these fees. With the restructuring of local calling areas that took place this past winter, NYNEX's charges for basic local service has increased to as follows:

Basic Residential Service	\$20.65 per month
Mileage Charge	3.65 " "
Access Charge	3.50 " "
Inside Wiring Maintenance	1.15 " "
Total	\$28.95 per month (plus tax)

Based on the above, I recommend increasing the fee to the Homeowners to \$29 per month for the first extension and to \$24 per month for additional extensions, effective April 1.

Please let me know your thoughts on this.
